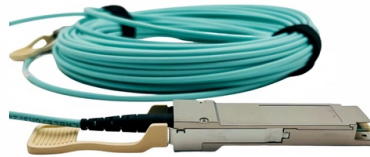

Fiber Connectivity for PBX Systems

IP-based PBXs such as the DS200 series can directly terminate fiber optic lines at the switchboard. Fiber connections support voice, video, and data simultaneously, and remote extensions can use IP phones, softphones, or VoIP-enabled devices from any location over the fiber network. Analog or digital PBXs can also use fiber, but typically require media converters or extenders. Devices like the F-4TEL or TC1901/TC1903 convert standard analog or POTS lines to fiber, allowing telephone lines to be extended over long distances. These converters can be configured as FXO (PBX trunk) or FXS (telephone set/fax machine) to match the PBX interface. They support features like caller ID, fax transmission, and remote management, and can operate over single-mode or multi-mode fiber for distances up to 100 miles depending on the model.

- Distance and Fiber Type: Short distances within a building often use multimode fiber, while longer distances between buildings typically use single-mode fiber.
- Number of Lines: Single or multiple PBX trunks can be extended over fiber using appropriate products (e.g., FC1x00 for single trunks, Emux for multiple trunks),.
