

Fiber optic connection to a 5-port gigabit switch

To connect a fiber optic line to a 5-port gigabit switch, you typically need an SFP module compatible with your switch, the correct fiber type (single-mode or multimode), and matching connectors such as LC or SC.

Required Equipment

- **SFP Module:** Most small gigabit switches do not have built-in fiber ports, so you need an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) module that matches your fiber type and speed. For gigabit connections, use a 1000BASE-SX (multimode) or 1000BASE-LX (single-mode) SFP module depending on your fiber and distance requirements .

- **Insert the SFP Module:** Plug the SFP module into the fiber port of your 5-port gigabit switch. Ensure it is fully seated and compatible with the switch model .
