Ribbon Fiber Optic Cables

Ribbon fiber cables consist of multiple optical fibers arranged side-by-side in a flat ribbon structure, typically containing 4 to 24 fibers per ribbon . This design allows high fiber density in a compact form, making it ideal for data centers, FTTH deployments, and backbone networks where space is limited . Ribbon cables facilitate mass fusion splicing, enabling multiple fibers to be spliced simultaneously, which significantly reduces installation time and labor costs .
