Multimode fiber (MMF) is an optical fiber with a larger core than single-mode fiber. 5 um for OM1 and 50 um for OM2, OM3, OM4 and OM5. This larger core allows easier light injection and lower-cost optical sources (LEDs and VCSELs), making multimode fiber the cost-effective choice for.
