Overview of Fiber Optic Ports

Fiber optic ports on managed switches allow data transmission over optical fiber, offering higher bandwidth, longer reach, and immunity to electromagnetic interference compared to copper Ethernet ports. These ports can support single-mode or multimode fiber, depending on the distance and application requirements (). Managed switches with fiber ports provide remote configuration, monitoring, and traffic management, unlike unmanaged switches. They support features such as VLAN segmentation, Quality of Service (QoS), port security, link aggregation, and redundancy, ensuring optimized performance and network reliability ().

Types and Speeds

- Port Speeds: Fiber ports can range from 1 Gbps, 2.5 Gbps, 10 Gbps, 40 Gbps, up to 100 Gbps, depending on the switch model and network requirements ().
- Port Types: Many switches use SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ modules, which allow flexible insertion of different fiber types and speeds ().
- Single-mode vs Multimode: Single-mode fiber supports longer distances (up to tens of kilometers), while multimode fiber is suitable for shorter distances (up to a few hundred meters) ().
