These entries are typically sealed with rubber grommets or other protective seals to prevent moisture, dust, and environmental contamination . **Splitter Modules:** Some splice boxes include splitter modules to divide optical signals into multiple fibers, enabling distribution to several endpoints . **Front Panel and Connectors:** The front panel provides access to connectors such as LC, SC, E2000®, or ST, allowing easy connection to in-house networks or patch panels. The panel is often removable for maintenance or expansion .
