Connecting to a Transceiver

- **Prepare the Fiber Cable:** Strip the outer jacket and buffer coating to expose the fiber strands. Ensure the fiber ends are clean and cleaved properly .
- **Splice or Connect Pigtails:** Inside the terminal box, the incoming fiber is either fusion-spliced to pre-terminated fiber pigtails or connected via adapters . Pigtails serve as the interface between the terminal box and the transceiver.
- **Use Adapters:** The pigtails terminate in connectors that plug into the transceiver's fiber port. Ensure the correct type of connector (e.g., LC or SC) matches the transceiver input .
