

Flame retardant for hot aisles in monitoring room

Hot aisles in monitoring rooms should use flame-retardant materials compliant with NFPA 75 and ANSI/UL 60950-1, combined with appropriate fire detection and suppression systems.

Flame-Retardant Materials

For hot aisles, all construction and enclosure materials should be low-flammability or flame-retardant to reduce fire risk. This includes:

- Aisle containment panels and barriers: Must meet ANSI/UL 60950-1 standards for low flammability and be listed for IT equipment enclosures .
- Cabling and insulation: Use plenum-rated or low-smoke, flame-retardant cables to prevent fire propagation along cable runs .
- Filters, liquids, and acoustical materials: Any materials associated with IT equipment should also comply with flame-retardant standards .

Fire Detection in Hot Aisles

High airflow in hot aisles can impede traditional smoke detection. Recommended solutions include:

- Aspirating smoke detection systems (e.g., FFAST) that sample air continuously along hot aisles, providing early warning even in high-airflow environments .
- Dual-stage detection or “double-knock” systems to reduce false alarms caused by dust or airflow disturbances .
