In fiber optic systems, a flange refers to a connector or adapter that allows two fiber optic pigtailed to be joined or connected to equipment such as an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) or patch panel . It does not house or protect fiber splices and is not designed for cable management or environmental protection. Flanges are typically small, interface-specific components, available in types like SC/PC or FC/PC, and are used for active connections rather than splicing cables .

What a Fiber Optic Splice Box Is

A fiber optic splice box (also called a splice closure or splice distributor) is an enclosure that houses and protects fiber splices. It provides mechanical strength, environmental protection, and cable management for fibers that are fused together using a fusion splicer . Splice boxes can be used indoors or outdoors and often include removable splice cassettes, front panels with connectors, and strain relief mechanisms . They are designed to accommodate multiple fibers and ensure long-term reliability of the spliced connections.
