- IP66/IP67: Dust-tight and protected against powerful water jets or temporary immersion; recommended for areas with heavy fog, high humidity, or frequent condensation events .

Testing involves simulating environmental conditions such as fog, rain, and dust to ensure no moisture penetrates the enclosure, which could compromise optical fibers or electrical components .
