

Full Process of Connecting Fiber Optic Cable to a Splice Box

Connecting a fiber optic cable to a splice box involves careful cable preparation, secure installation in the closure, precise splicing, and proper fiber management to ensure low-loss, reliable connections.

1. Fiber Cable Preparation

Begin by removing the outer jacket of the fiber optic cable, along with any shielding or armor, to expose the loose tubes. Leave approximately 3 meters of cable for preparation. Clean the exposed fibers and strength members using a suitable cleaning solution, and abrade the outer jacket for about 150 mm to ensure a clean surface for sealing . Use proper fiber strippers to remove the buffer coating without damaging the fiber, and handle all fibers carefully to avoid injury .

2. Installing the Cable into the Splice Box

Select sealing rings that match the cable diameter and place them on the cable. Insert the cable into the designated entry port of the splice closure. Connect and ground any shielding layers, then wrap self-adhesive sealing tape between the rings to create a sealed cable end. Secure the cable to the closure base using a hose clamp, and identify outgoing and customer fibers with colored nylon ties (green for outgoing, blue for customer) . Seal any unused ports with plugs and tape to prevent moisture ingress.
