Coatings like zinc or zinc-aluminum protect the steel from rust, extending the cable's lifespan even when exposed to moisture, UV radiation, or extreme temperatures . Different stainless steel grades (e.g., 302, 316) are selected based on environmental conditions and required tensile strength.
