Fiber optic cables are sensitive to bending and pulling. Terminal boxes provide strain relief through cable clamps and grommets, transferring tensile loads from the fiber to the chassis. They also enforce minimum bend-radius control, typically ≥ 30 mm for bend-insensitive fibers, preventing microbends and signal attenuation .
