- **Point-to-Multipoint Architecture:** A single optical fiber can serve multiple users through passive optical splitters, which do not require power to operate. This reduces operational costs and simplifies maintenance .
- **Long Reach:** GPON can cover distances of up to 20 kilometers without significant signal loss, allowing for extensive deployment in urban and rural areas .
- **Secure Transmission:** GPON employs strong encryption methods, such as AES, to safeguard user data during transmission .
