Galvanizing of cable trays is primarily divided into electro-galvanizing (cold galvanizing) and hot-dip galvanizing (HDG), with pre-galvanized steel as a preliminary option.

Types of Galvanized Cable Trays

- **Pre-Galvanized Cable Trays** These trays are made from steel that has been galvanized before fabrication. The zinc coating is applied to the steel sheet prior to forming the tray, providing basic corrosion protection suitable for indoor or less harsh environments. Pre-galvanized trays are commonly used in industrial and commercial applications where moderate protection is sufficient .
- **Electro-Galvanized (Cold Galvanized) Cable Trays** In this process, a thin layer of zinc is deposited onto the steel surface through electrolysis. The coating is bright, uniform, and relatively thin (typically $\geq 12\mu\text{m}$), offering limited corrosion resistance. Electro-galvanized trays are suitable for indoor use but are not recommended for marine or highly humid environments due to the risk of rapid rusting .
- **Hot-Dip Galvanized (HDG) Cable Trays** Hot-dip galvanizing involves submerging the steel tray into molten zinc, forming a thick zinc-iron alloy layer topped with pure zinc. This method provides superior corrosion resistance, excellent adhesion, and durability, making it ideal for outdoor, coastal, or industrial environments. The typical coating thickness is around $39\text{--}45\mu\text{m}$, corresponding to a zinc mass of $275\text{--}325\text{g/m}^2$, depending on steel thickness . HDG trays are preferred for long-term exposure to harsh conditions.
