The minimum spacing between multiple grounding electrodes is 6 feet, but optimal performance is achieved with a separation of at least twice the rod length.

NEC Requirements and Minimum Spacing

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), when installing multiple ground rods, a supplemental grounding electrode must be placed at least 6 feet away from any other electrode to ensure they are considered independent electrodes . This minimum distance prevents overlapping of high-resistance soil zones around each rod, which would reduce the effectiveness of the grounding system .

Recommended Spacing for Optimal Performance

While 6 feet is the code minimum, best practices suggest spacing rods at least twice the length of the rod. For example, an 8-foot rod should ideally be spaced 16 feet apart. This maximizes the independent dissipation of fault currents into the earth and lowers overall system resistance .
