Overview

A beam splitter, essentially, is a device capable of directing light into two distinct paths. When a light beam encounters these cubes, half of it penetrates the glass, while the other half gets reflected. Instead of allowing all incoming light to transmit straight through or reflect entirely, the glass is engineered to partially reflect and partially transmit light according to defined.
