Using Cable Trays as Grounding Conductors

Metallic cable trays can serve as the equipment grounding conductor (EGC) in installations where qualified personnel will service the system. This means the tray itself can provide a low-impedance path for fault currents, reducing the risk of electric shock or equipment damage. All metallic trays must be grounded according to NEC Article 250.96, regardless of whether they are used as the EGC .

Connecting a Separate Ground Wire

Even when the tray is used as an EGC, it is often recommended to run a separate grounding conductor along the tray, especially for wire mesh trays or when supporting cables with built-in EGCs. This wire is typically bonded to each or alternate tray sections using grounding clamps, which also mechanically secure the conductor to prevent displacement under fault conditions .

Key Guidelines for Ground Wire Connection

- **Material Selection:** Use copper, hot-dip galvanized steel, or stainless steel for corrosion resistance and good conductivity .
- **Insulation:** For aluminum trays, use an insulated conductor to prevent electrolytic corrosion, removing insulation only at bonding points with tin- or zinc-plated connectors
