

Grounding Requirements for Mobile Equipment Room Power Distribution Boxes



Summary of Content

Mobile equipment room power distribution boxes must be grounded to a common protective ground bar with low-resistance connections, using appropriately sized conductors, and following OSHA, IEEE, and equipment-specific standards.

Key Grounding Principles

Common Grounding Point: All protective grounds for devices, including mobile base stations, transmission equipment, and power supply units, should be connected to a general ground bar in the equipment room. This ensures a single reference point and minimizes potential differences between equipment components (Huawei specifications) . **Grounding Conductors:** Use yellow-green insulated copper conductors with sufficient cross-sectional area. For main protective grounds, a minimum of 25 sq. mm (0.039 sq. in.) is recommended, while short-circuiting cables connecting cabinets can be 6 sq. mm (0.009 sq. in.) and no longer than 300 mm (11.8 in.) . All metal parts of cabinets, doors, and ventilation pipes must be bonded to the ground system. **Grounding Resistance:**

- Comprehensive communication buildings: ≤ 1 ohm
 - Ordinary communication offices: ≤ 5 ohms
 - High earth resistance areas: ≤ 10 ohms
