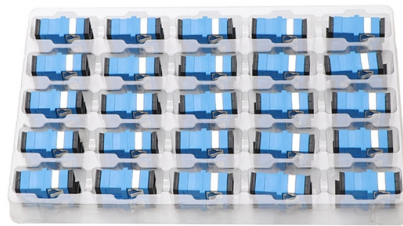


Grounding of cable trays in underground parking garage
