

Height of secondary distribution box on construction site



Summary of Content

The bottom of a fixed secondary distribution box on a construction site should be installed between 1.3 meters and 1.5 meters above the ground.

Installation Height Guidelines

For fixed secondary distribution boxes, the vertical distance from the ground to the bottom of the box should be greater than 1.3 meters but less than 1.5 meters. For mobile distribution boxes, the bottom should be between 0.6 meters and 1.5 meters above the ground. These heights ensure the boxes are easily accessible for operation and maintenance while remaining safe from water, dust, and accidental impact .

Placement Considerations

- Location: Install the box in a ventilated, dry area away from harmful media such as gas, steam, liquids, or heat sources .
- Spacing: Ensure there is enough space for two people to work simultaneously around the box, and avoid stacking items or placing obstacles nearby .
- Distance from switch boxes: The horizontal distance between the secondary distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the switch box should be within 3 meters of the equipment it controls .
- Protection: All boxes must be rainproof and dustproof, and made of iron plate or high-quality insulating material with a minimum thickness of 1.5 mm .
