

How about using a 90-degree angle for cable trays in low-voltage wiring



Summary of Content

Yes, 90-degree bends can be used in cable trays for low-voltage wiring, but care must be taken to respect cable bend radius and manufacturer recommendations.

NEC and Code Considerations

The National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 392 allows cable trays to be bent in the field, including 90-degree turns, provided the installation meets structural and support requirements (NEC 392.18(A)). There is no strict minimum radius for low-voltage cables in the NEC unless specified by the cable manufacturer. However, proper support and secure fastening are required to prevent stress on the cables at bends.

Cable Bend Radius

Even though a 90-degree angle is permissible, the bend radius of the cables themselves must be considered. Low-voltage cables, such as control or communication cables, can be damaged if pulled too tightly around sharp corners. Standard practice is to use elbows or radius bends that meet or exceed the minimum bend radius recommended by the cable manufacturer. For example, a 600 mm centerline radius may be sufficient for many cables, but always verify against the specific cable's requirements.

Practical Installation Tips

- Use pre-fabricated 90-degree elbows or field-fabricated bends with smooth curves to reduce stress on the cables.
