- **Wire Mesh (Basket) Cable Tray** Made from welded steel wires, wire mesh trays are lightweight, flexible, and easy to modify on-site. They are ideal for low-voltage, data, and telecom cables in IT networks, office buildings, and data centers .
- **Channel Cable Tray** Channel trays are compact, economical, and designed for light cable loads. They are suitable for short runs, lighting circuits, and instrumentation cables, especially where space is limited .
