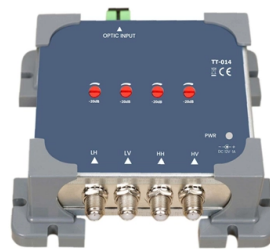

Fiber Optic Cabling and Transceivers

To connect switches via fiber, you typically use duplex fiber optic cables, which consist of two strands: one for transmitting and one for receiving signals. The choice between single-mode fiber and multimode fiber depends on the distance: multimode is suitable for runs under 1000 feet, while single-mode is preferred for longer distances over 1000 feet. Switches require SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ transceiver modules that match the type of fiber being used. These modules are inserted into the switch ports and handle the conversion between electrical and optical signals. Ensure that the SFP modules are compatible with the switch's bandwidth (1G, 10G, or higher) and that the fiber strands are connected in a reversed configuration (A to B, B to A) to maintain proper send/receive alignment.
