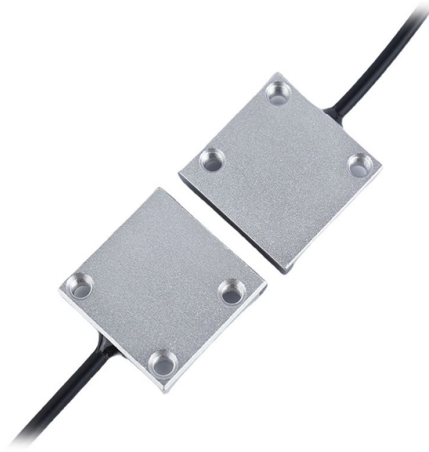


How deep is the cable tray hanger



Summary of Content

Cable tray hangers should provide sufficient depth to support the tray, maintain cable spacing, and comply with standard load and clearance requirements.

Standard Depth Considerations

The depth of a cable tray hanger is closely related to the side rail height or tray depth, which controls vertical stacking capacity and affects cable fill, heat dissipation, and NEC compliance . Typical cable tray depths vary by tray type:

- Ladder trays: Side rail heights commonly range from 2 to 6 inches, with deeper trays used for heavy power cables or high cable counts .
- Perforated trays: Depths are usually 2 to 4 inches, balancing containment with ventilation .
- Channel trays: Compact systems with depths around 1.5 to 3 inches, suitable for light-duty or control wiring .
- Wire mesh (basket) trays: Depths vary depending on wire diameter and support spacing, often 3 to 6 inches, providing flexibility for data and telecom cables .

Hanger Spacing and Support

Hangers must be installed to support the tray load and prevent deflection. General recommendations include:

- Maximum span: Typically 5 to 10 feet for ladder and perforated trays, depending on material thickness and load .
- Rung spacing: For ladder trays, 6 to 9 inches between rungs is preferred to maintain cable support and prevent sagging .
