

How far should the fiber optic distribution box be from the house



Summary of Content

A fiber optic distribution box can typically be installed several hundred meters from a household, with the final “drop” cable connecting the home usually limited to 100–300 meters depending on network design and signal quality.

Typical Installation Setup

In a fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) network, the fiber optic distribution box serves as a termination point for feeder or distribution cables coming from the central office or fiber distribution hub (FDH) and provides connections for multiple subscribers . From this box, a drop cable runs directly to the household, carrying the optical signal to the optical network terminal (ONT) inside the home .

Distance Considerations

- **Passive Optical Network (PON) Architecture:** Most FTTH networks use PONs, where a single fiber from the central office is split to serve multiple homes. The optical signal can travel up to 20 km from the central office to the distribution box without amplification, but the practical distance from the distribution box to the home is much shorter .
- **Drop Cable Length:** The fiber drop from the distribution box to the household is usually 100–300 meters for single-family homes. Longer distances may require higher-quality fiber, careful splicing, or signal boosters to maintain low attenuation and high-speed performance .
