Elevated installations or outdoor projects often require scaffolding, lifts, or additional safety measures, which increase labor and coordination expenses . Environmental factors such as exposure to moisture, chemicals, or extreme temperatures may also necessitate specialized coatings or materials, further affecting costs .
