

How long does it take to install a railway communication tower

Installing a railway communication tower typically takes between 2 to 4 weeks for full construction and system integration, though rapid-deployment units can be operational in a few hours.

Standard Tower Installation

For a conventional railway communication tower, the process involves site preparation, foundation construction, tower assembly, equipment installation, and testing. According to industry examples, building a telecommunications tower from ground preparation to foundation completion can take around 19 days for a standard project, including surveying, excavation, concrete pouring, and reinforcement work . After the tower structure is erected, the installation of antennas, transmitters, receivers, and cabling for railway communication systems such as GSM-R, SISS, and CCTV can add additional days, depending on complexity . Full testing, commissioning, and handover to operational status are also included in this timeline.

Rapid Deployment Options

For temporary or emergency railway communication needs, rapid-deployment towers such as trailer-mounted Cell on Wheels (COW) or Cell on Light Truck (COLT) units can be set up much faster. A standard COW can be deployed in 30 minutes to 4 hours, depending on height, guying requirements, and terrain, while a COLT can be operational in under 20 minutes . These units are ideal for short-term coverage or testing but require additional time for full network integration and signal activation.
