A distribution box (also called a breaker panel, consumer unit, or DB box) divides incoming electrical power into multiple subsidiary circuits, each protected by a circuit breaker or fuse. The number of circuits depends on the panel's design, the number of slots (ways) available, and the type of breakers used.

- Domestic panels: Usually have 6 to 24 ways, often split into sections for RCD-protected circuits (sockets, lighting) and non-RCD circuits (alarms, specialized equipment), .
- Commercial or industrial panels: Can accommodate more circuits, often using bolt-on breakers and larger busbars to handle higher currents .
- Future-proofing: It is common to leave extra slots for potential expansion, such as adding circuits for solar panels, EV chargers, or additional appliances .

Factors Affecting Circuit Count

- Load requirements: Each circuit should match the electrical load it serves to prevent overloads .
