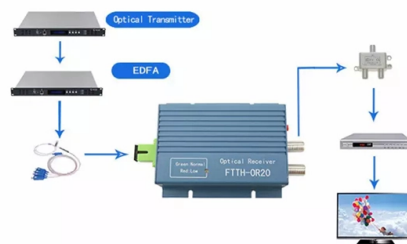

- Check the panel label: Most panels list the number of available breaker slots.
