

# How many circuits should the circuit breaker in the distribution box be configured with



## Summary of Content

The maximum number of circuits in a distribution box is determined by the panel's design and manufacturer specifications, not by a fixed code limit.

### Panel Design and Manufacturer Limits

Modern electrical panels are designed with a specific number of breaker slots, which dictates the maximum number of circuits they can safely accommodate. For example, a standard 200-amp residential panel typically has 30 to 42 physical slots, with each slot holding a single-pole breaker for a 120-volt circuit or half of a double-pole breaker for a 240-volt circuit. The bus bar inside the panel has connection points that limit the number of full-size breakers that can be installed.

### Use of Tandem or Slimline Breakers

To increase the number of circuits beyond the standard slot count, tandem (duplex) breakers can be used. These breakers fit two independent circuits into a single slot, effectively doubling the number of 120-volt circuits in panels designed to accept them. However, not all panels are rated for tandem breakers, and the panel's documentation will specify which slots can safely accommodate them.
