Overview

Non-compliance risks safety or code violations. A junction. Why is understanding junction boxes important when figuring out how many you can have on a circuit?

Because they are the physical manifestation of electrical connections! Each box could represent a place where the circuit is being tapped or extended. A junction box protects wire connections from physical damage, reduces shock and fire risks. The main NEC requirements for junction boxes are found in NEC Article 314, which covers outlet boxes, device boxes, pull boxes, junction boxes, conduit bodies, and handhole enclosures. The box has a specific volume, usually measured in cubic inches, which determines its capacity to hold wires.
