

How many electrical circuits are needed in a four-bedroom apartment

General Guidelines

For a modern NEC-compliant home or apartment, the number of circuits depends on square footage, number of bedrooms, bathrooms, and major appliances. A four-bedroom, three-bathroom apartment of approximately 2,800 sq ft typically requires 24-30 circuits . This includes:

- General-purpose circuits for lighting and outlets in bedrooms, living areas, and hallways.

- Bathroom circuits to comply with NEC requirements for GFCI protection.
- Small Appliance Branch Circuits (SABCs) for kitchen and dining areas, usually two 20-amp circuits .

Circuit Breakdown Example

- Bedrooms (4): 1-2 general-purpose 15A or 20A circuits per bedroom for outlets and lighting.
- Living/Dining Areas: 2-3 circuits for general lighting and receptacles.
