

How many levels of electrical distribution boxes are used in the residential building

Residential buildings typically use a tertiary-level distribution box, which delivers mains electricity (220–240V) to individual units and circuits.

Distribution Box Levels

Electrical distribution is often organized into three levels:

- **Primary Distribution Box:** Receives high-voltage power (e.g., 10kV) from the utility and steps it down via transformers. It is not directly used by household equipment and contains isolation switches and large circuit breakers .
- **Secondary Distribution Box:** Receives low-voltage three-phase power (e.g., 0.4kV) from the transformer and distributes it to multiple buildings. It typically contains large three-phase breakers .
- **Tertiary Distribution Box:** Installed within each residential building or unit, this box provides single-phase mains electricity (220–240V) to outlets, lighting, and appliances. It contains single-phase circuit breakers, residual current devices (RCDs), and surge protection .

Key Features of Residential Distribution Boxes

- **Voltage and Current Rating:** Usually 220–240V, 100A minimum for a single-family home according to NEC standards .
- **Components:** Includes circuit breakers, RCDs, surge protectors, and busbars for safe distribution .
