The SFP module pinout is a standardized 20-pin electrical interface defined by the SFF Committee's INF-8074i Multi-Source Agreement (MSA). It enables hot-pluggable communication between an optical transceiver and a host board, integrating high-speed differential data pairs (TX/RX), 3.3V DC power. Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) is a compact, hot-pluggable network interface module format used for both telecommunication and data communications applications. These modules, including SFP, SFP+, and SFP28, are widely used in enterprise networks, data centers, and carrier-grade deployments. Though small, the pins on SFP modules are essential to network stability. Table 1 provides the connector pinout information for the SFP+ network ports. SFP can be regarded as a pluggable version of SFF.
