

How tall is the electrical panel in my home



Summary of Content

Residential electrical panels should be installed so that the highest operating handle of any circuit breaker is no more than 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) above the floor.

Standard Height Guidelines

The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that the center of the grip of the operating handle of the highest circuit breaker must not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (79 inches or 2.0 meters) from the floor or working platform . This ensures that the panel is easily accessible for routine maintenance, emergency shut-offs, and safe operation without the need for ladders or stools . While the panel enclosure itself may extend slightly higher, the point of control must remain within this accessible range.

Clearance and Accessibility

In addition to height, the NEC requires a clear working space around the panel:

- Depth: Minimum of 3 feet (36 inches) in front of the panel for safe operation .
- Width: At least 30 inches or the width of the panel, whichever is greater .
- Vertical clearance: From the floor up to at least 6 feet 7 inches or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater .
- Panel door: Must open at least 90 degrees without obstruction . These clearances ensure safe access for electricians and homeowners and prevent hazards during emergencies.
