

How to add wires to a vertical cable tray

Planning and Preparation

Before connecting wires, plan the tray route carefully, considering clearance from other utilities, load capacity, and separation between power and data cables . Ensure the tray is properly mounted and supported, with load-bearing supports spaced according to manufacturer specifications, typically 1.5 meters apart for vertical runs .

Securing Wires

- Use cable ties or clamps to secure wires close to their connection points, reducing stress on the cables and preventing sagging .
- Maintain spacing between different cable types to prevent interference; dividers can be used for power and data separation .
- Organize cables neatly along the tray, avoiding overcrowding to prevent overheating and insulation damage .

Grounding and Bonding

- Metal trays must be continuously bonded to the building's main earth system using bonding jumpers .
- For non-galvanized trays, use crimped copper lugs at connection points; for galvanized trays, use anti-loosening bolts with spring washers .
