A secondary distribution box is assembled by integrating the transformer, low-voltage switchgear, busbars, and protective devices in a compact, modular enclosure with organized wiring and safety features.

Overview

A secondary distribution box (or unit substation) is a close-coupled assembly that combines primary high-voltage equipment, a three-phase transformer, and secondary low-voltage switchgear in a single enclosure . This design minimizes cable lengths, reduces power losses, improves voltage regulation, and enhances service continuity .

Step-by-Step Assembly Method

- Enclosure Preparation
 - Select a suitable metal or composite cabinet with adequate space for the transformer, busbars, breakers, and wiring channels.
 - Install mounting brackets and supports for heavy components like transformers and busbars .
- Transformer Installation
 - Position the three-phase power transformer centrally within the enclosure.
 - Secure the transformer using bolts and vibration-damping mounts to ensure stability and reduce mechanical stress .
