

How to best insert fiber optic cables into cable trays

Fiber optic cables should be carefully routed into cable trays while respecting bend radius, minimizing mechanical stress, and securing cables properly to maintain signal integrity.

1. Choose the Right Cable Tray

Select a tray type suitable for your environment and cable load. Wire basket trays are ideal for data centers with many small cables, allowing smooth turns and minimal stress, while ladder trays are better for heavy backbone cables in industrial settings, providing strong support over long distances. Ensure the tray is free of sharp edges and debris that could damage the cable jacket.

2. Prepare the Cable

Keep protective material on the cable reel until installation. Avoid exposing the cable to extreme temperatures or mechanical stress. For outdoor or prolonged installations, use additional protective covering if the cable will remain outside for more than 24 hours. Always check the cable's minimum bend radius and maximum pulling tension from the manufacturer's datasheet.

3. Route the Cable

- Respect the bend radius: Maintain at least 20 times the cable diameter when pulling dynamically and 10 times when static in the tray. Avoid sharp 90-degree turns.
- Use figure-8 loops for long pulls to prevent twisting and kinking.
