

How to bury optical cables

Direct Burial Methods

Trenching: A common method involves digging a trench to lay the cable directly in the ground. The trench bottom should be flat and free of debris, with a layer of fine soil or sand to cushion the cable. In rocky or gravelly areas, a protective layer of mortar or sand is recommended to prevent damage from sharp edges. Standard burial depths vary by soil type and location, typically ranging from 0.8 to 1.5 meters, with deeper placement in areas prone to frost, erosion, or heavy traffic . **Plowing:** For long runs across soft soil, a cable plow can be used to simultaneously cut a narrow trench and lay the cable. This method is efficient for large-scale installations and minimizes surface disruption. Armored cables are often preferred in plowed installations to resist crushing and rodent damage .

Conduit Installation

In areas where additional protection is needed, fiber optic cables can be pulled through buried conduits, typically made of PVC or HDPE. Conduits may include innerducts to facilitate future cable upgrades. Conduit installation is especially useful under roads, sidewalks, or in urban areas where repeated digging is likely. A detectable marker tape is often buried above the conduit to aid future location and prevent accidental damage .
