

How to calculate pigtail deployment

- Straight-line distance: Measure the direct distance between devices as a baseline.
- Routing path: Include detours around obstacles, through conduits, or along cable trays, which increases the required length.
- Bending radius: Ensure the pigtail meets the minimum bending radius to prevent signal loss or fiber damage. Typically, multimode fibers require a minimum radius of 30mm, and single-mode fibers about 10mm.
- Reserved length: Leave extra fiber at device interfaces and ODFs for fixation, splicing, and future adjustments .
