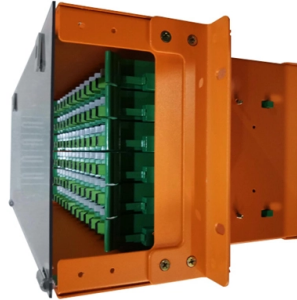


How to classify 288 ribbon optical cables



Summary of Content

288-fiber ribbon optical cables are classified by ribbon groups, sub-unit tubes, and standardized color codes for proper identification and splicing.

Ribbon and Fiber Organization

A 288-fiber cable typically consists of 24 ribbons, each containing 12 fibers. These ribbons are often housed in sub-unit tubes for easier handling and management, especially in high-density environments like data centers (). The ribbons may be flexible or rollable, allowing them to be compacted within the cable while still enabling easy separation for splicing ().

Color Coding

Each fiber within a ribbon and each ribbon within the cable is assigned a specific color to facilitate identification. Standard color sequences are used to ensure consistency across installations:

- Fibers within a ribbon follow a 12-color sequence: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua.
- Ribbons within the cable are also color-coded or numbered to distinguish each 12-fiber group (). For cables manufactured before 2022, a clear fiber may occupy position 8 in each ribbon, which is important to note when sequencing for splicing ().
