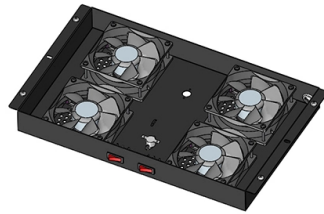


How to configure network cables in a network cabinet
