

How to connect a fiber optic pigtail to an 86 panel

To connect a fiber optic pigtail to an 86 panel, you splice the bare end of the pigtail to the incoming fiber and plug the factory-terminated connector into the panel port.

Step 1: Gather Tools and Materials
