

How to connect a fusion splicer to a fiber optic cable

Using a fusion splicer involves preparing the fiber ends, aligning them precisely, and fusing them with controlled heat to create a low-loss, permanent connection.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber

- Strip the outer jacket of the fiber cable using a cable stripper, exposing about 3–5 cm of the fiber core ().
- Remove the acrylate coating with a fiber stripper in a smooth, perpendicular motion.
- Clean the fiber with a lint-free wipe and fiber optic cleaning solution, sliding the wipe toward the fiber tip until it squeaks, indicating it is free of debris ().

Step 2: Cleave the Fiber

- Place the stripped fiber in the cleaver unit on the V-groove.
- Close the holder and cleave the fiber to create a smooth, flat end. Proper cleaving is critical for low-loss splicing ().

Step 3: Insert Fiber into the Splicer

- Open the fiber holders of the fusion splicer and place each fiber end in the clamps.
- If using a splice protection sleeve, slide it onto one fiber before clamping ().
