- Direct-burial cable for underground runs.
- Indoor-outdoor cable for building entry points. Ensure the cable type matches the network requirements and environmental conditions to prevent damage or performance issues .

Step 3: Laying and Routing the Cable

Carefully route the cable along the planned path:

- Use UV-resistant clamps or hooks for aerial installations.
