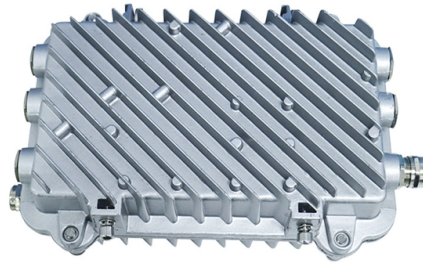


How to connect fiber optic cables for surveillance to a switch

To connect a fiber optic cable for a surveillance system, use SFP modules or media converters to link the fiber to PoE switches, ensuring proper power and data transmission to IP cameras.

Equipment Needed

- Fiber Optic Cable: Pre-terminated single-mode or multimode fiber with LC connectors for quick installation and low signal loss .
- PoE Switch with SFP Ports: Provides both power and data to cameras and allows fiber uplink connections .
- SFP Modules: Small Form-factor Pluggable modules that convert optical signals to the switch interface. BiDi SFP modules can transmit and receive over a single fiber strand .
- Media Converter (optional): Converts fiber signals to Ethernet if the switch does not have SFP ports or for connecting dissimilar media types .
- Ethernet Cables: To connect cameras to the PoE switch.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Plan the Layout: Determine camera locations, distances, and fiber routing (overhead or buried) to calculate cable lengths .
- Install Fiber Cable: Securely lay the fiber along the planned route, using a figure-8 pattern to prevent twisting and maintain signal integrity .
