

How to connect the cable management module



Summary of Content

Connect each management module to the management network using redundant Ethernet connections, ensuring proper port configuration and network redundancy.

Step-by-Step Connection Guide

1. Identify Management Module Ports Each management module typically has two or more Ethernet ports dedicated to chassis management. These ports are separate from the data network and are used to access the management interfaces of the chassis components .
2. Connect to the Management Network
 - Use standard Ethernet cables to connect each management module port to a top-of-rack (ToR) switch or management network switch.
 - Ensure that both ports on the switch are enabled and configured on the same network and VLAN to provide redundancy .
 - There is no strict requirement to prefer one port over the other; both can be used interchangeably .
3. Redundant Cabling for Fault Tolerance
 - Connect each management module to either the same switch or to two separate redundant switches. This ensures that if one link or switch fails, the other provides uninterrupted management access .
