Physical Connection

Logical Configuration

- Configure VLANs: Create interconnection VLANs on the core switch and assign the appropriate interfaces to these VLANs. This ensures proper segmentation and traffic flow between switches .
- Assign IP addresses: Configure IP addresses on the core switch interfaces that connect to other network devices, such as BRASs, firewalls, or distribution switches. This allows routing and management of traffic across the network .
