

How to determine the total number of circuits in a distribution box



Summary of Content

You can determine the number of circuits in a distribution box by counting the individual breakers, considering single-pole, double-pole, and three-phase breakers, and accounting for the panel's design and load requirements.

Step 1: Identify the Breakers

Distribution boxes, also called fuseboards or load centers, contain MCBs (miniature circuit breakers). Each breaker represents a circuit. Single-pole breakers protect 120V circuits and occupy one slot, while double-pole breakers protect 240V circuits and occupy two adjacent slots. Some panels may also have triple-width breakers for three-phase circuits, which should be included in your count .

Step 2: Count the Breakers

- Open the panel cover safely.
- Count all individual circuit breakers.
- Exclude RCDs (residual current devices) and the main switch, unless they are part of a dedicated circuit.
- Include tandem or double-stuff breakers, which allow two circuits in a single slot .

Step 3: Consider Panel Capacity
